Services Completed: Site research was undertaken to discover deeds, right of ways, subdivisions, or other documentation relating to the project site. Field surveys located street lines, property markers, the river edge or walls, utilities, and other pertinent features. Data reduction and drafting produced and plotted the ALTA plan.

An ALTA survey is a more intensive survey than a boundary survey. In an ALTA survey, documents show information about property boundaries and easements, as well as utilities and improvements. An ALTA survey can be thought of as a boundary survey, a title survey, and an improvement location survey all in one.
